Community TV Due To Be Switched Off.

The Federal Government have advised of their intension to not extend Community TV Licences for a further period. This means that, at this stage, the remaining stations will go “off air” at the end of June. At this time, it will not affect the planned broadcasts of “Inline Plus”, as we expect to fit within the time limits imposed on Community TV.

Mixed feelings, as shows near completion.

There are mixed feelings as the shows near completion, with the news that Community TV is due to be shutdown at the end of June. Despite this, we have had to “get on with it”, as it has now become a matter of “it’s now or never”. It has also been difficult working on the shows, knowing that a number of people in Melbourne do not like the project. It is frustrating “tippy toing” around these people and their associated events, but the show must go on at this stage, despite this.

In this issue, we introduce a new broadcaster for “Inline Plus” in Aurora TV on Foxtel. Due to being self-funded, this will be limited to four episodes, unless we manage to sell the available sponsorship time on our three broadcasters. If you know of anyone who might be interested in this opportunity, please let them know about us!

Northern Access Television is planning the future beyond C31’s free-to-air broadcasts. We will be introducing a new Video Portal, at this stage to be called “NATter Video”, where all of NAT’s programs can be brought together in one place for easy viewing. We will hopefully have more news on this in future newsletters.

The next major work on the show is a visit to Melbourne and Sydney to shoot episodes there. These will be done almost at the “last minute”, so they will need to be edited quickly after the trips, if not also DURING the trips! Being based in Echuca has had its problems, adding extra costs to our show, but we still have managed to do quite well, despite being so far away. See you next issue with more news!

“Inline Plus” to go to Aurora TV on Foxtel (Channel 173)



Due to the fact that Sydney has no free to air Community TV, we will be submitting “Inline Plus” to Aurora TV, which is seen on Foxtel Channel 173, on the basic package. The four Sydney and Melbourne episodes will be the ones running on this station, with a fifth to be decided by a “lucky dip” draw from all other episodes (see below). The reason for this is that Aurora charges an airtime fee of \$550 per episode, and being a self-funded project - we can afford to broadcast only five episodes at this price. However the chosen four episodes will most likely air four times each on the channel in different timeslots.

The Aurora TV broadcasts will likely be in November /December 2020, while we budget for the broadcast airtime fees. Please stay tuned for further news about the proposed timeslots.

So all episodes shot in Adelaide and Melbourne will be put into the draw to be the “fifth” Aurora episode. The draw will be conducted LIVE in the near future on our Facebook and YouTube (once our program lineup is locked-in). STAY TUNED for more details of the draw!

P.S. I am sorry that it has to be decided this way, but I think it is the fairest method to decide which episode runs on Aurora!

Sydney & Melbourne shoots postponed.

The Sydney and Melbourne shoots have been postponed due to “Coronavirus panic”. They will resume around October / November. Apologies for any inconvenience this may cause.

There are now only two Community TV Stations left on the air, being C31 Melbourne and 44 Adelaide., after WTV Perth closed down early in late February. The last minute “ad hoc” extensions to Community TV has taken their toll on the station, affecting their ability to survive to the end of the licence period. WTV Perth will now provide online programming of a local WA nature via their YouTube channel. We are obviously disappointed about this, but “Inline Plus” will continue on the remaining two stations.

Each Community TV producer has a certain amount of Advertising Sponsorship time to sell on their programs, and we are no exception. We have available 15 and 30 second “video” spots on C31 Melbourne and 44 Adelaide, and 30 second spots on Aurora TV on Foxtel (available on the basic package nationally). Sponsorship rates are available on application, and you may be surprised what these sponsorships cost!

In the case of Aurora TV, we have released the fee for a 30 second spot. It will be \$275 per 30 seconds / episode. All sponsorships will be sold on a “per station / per episode” basis, meaning that you don’t have to sponsor the whole series, or all of the broadcast locations.

Being a self-funded project - any sponsorships we sell will be applied towards the production costs, and also towards the airtime fees on Aurora TV.

What is MELfeed Video?

MELfeed.video is a Web TV Service for Melbourne, Australia. Our service features new and old Community TV Programs and other video content from time to time. Programming is presented at least one night a week (currently Monday nights) to start with, via Live Streams on YouTube Live, and the broadcasts will be available for replay soon after. The website will also showcase some on demand programs and content from the owner of the site and the participating Community TV groups, whether that is via our own YouTube, or other accounts associated with those programs. The aim is to provide a service to promote some of the lesser known community TV programs, past and present, on C31 Melbourne. These programs tend to not get much promotion on the station!

Initial programs on this service will be drawn from the libraries of Northern Access Television (NAT) and Melbourne East Television Regional Organisation (METRO TV). Other program providers that wish to join with our web TV service can ask us to consider their programs to be included as part of the service. Sometimes serious, sometimes playful, these programs will find a “second” home here on MELfeed.video! – The service is owned and operated by Michael Costello (who trades as VideBus) and participation in the service by programs and providers will be at his sole discretion.


